- Who:** Girls ages 5-14 (current Masuk students are not eligible)
- What:** The Panther Cheerleading camp is a four day instructional camp. Players will receive expert instruction from experienced high school coaches and cheerleaders. Emphasis will be placed on the basics of stunting, dance, jumps, cheers and tumbling. Our goal is to teach the fundamentals of cheerleading in a positive, safe and fun environment. Players will receive instruction in all phases of cheerleading, dance, jumps and stunting. Participants will be taught in small groups each day. Additionally, Camp Participants will learn cheers and perform a routine for spectators on the final day of camp.
